

Calling all lovers of books, chocolate, coffee and tea!

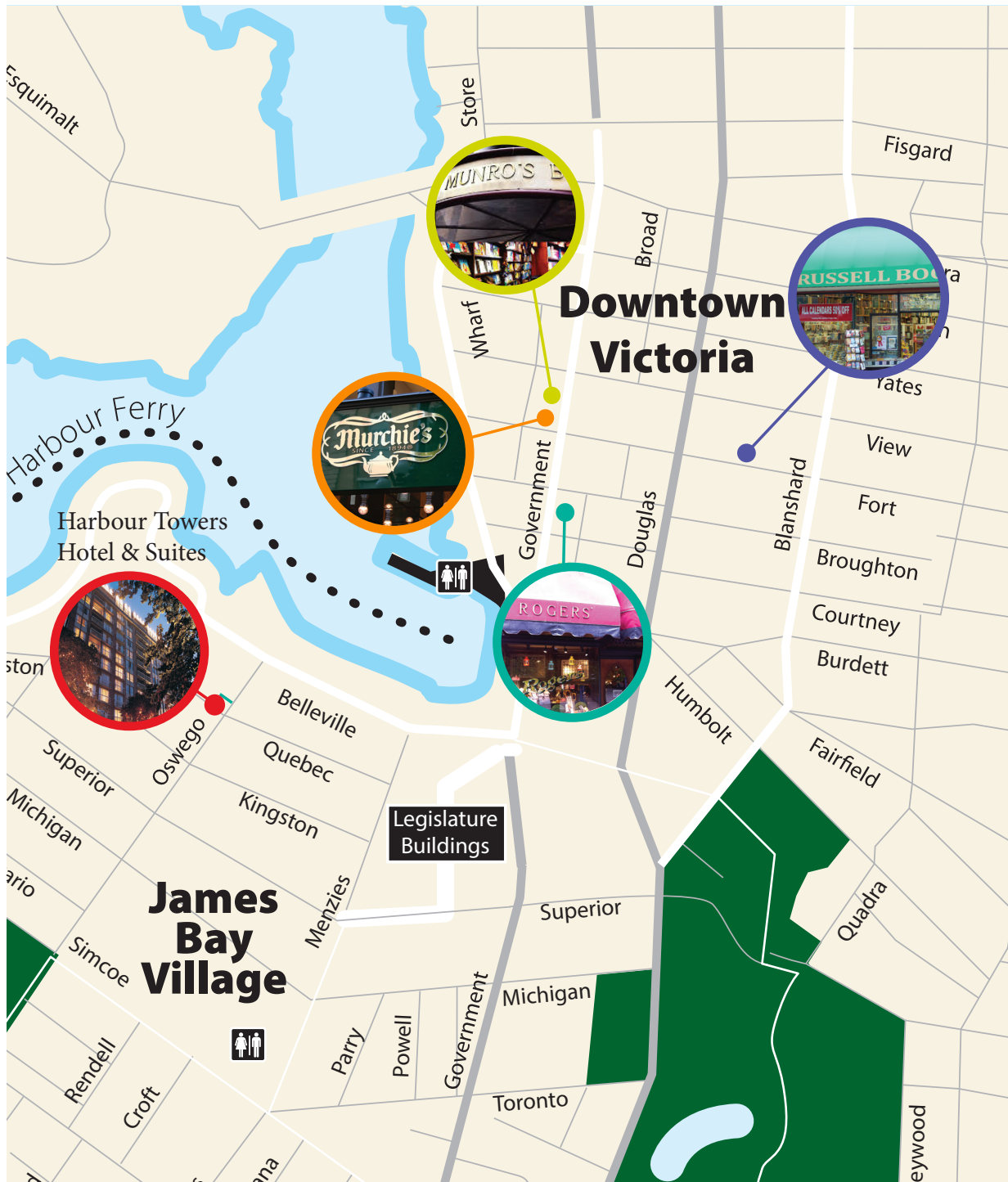
